2013—The Year So Far

This has been an exciting year at Eagles. God has blessed us with an amazing group of students, additional volunteers, a new staff member in the office, and a fresh format of our curriculum. It has been wonderful. Now, we want to share a brief outline of the goals, activities, and classes that our students have experienced so far this year. ~ Blessings from The Eagles Team

Goal One: In the first week that students arrive



at Eagles we want every student to feel safe, accepted, and excited about their future at Eagles. This is achieved through a week long

camp facilitated by Solid Rock Educational Trust. During this year's camp six students accepted the Lord Jesus as their Saviour!

Goal Two: The second year students are set on a course for leadership development. They are prepared to mentor the first year students by praying for and with them, and they teach them about the duties on the farm. This year the second years also assist staff by taking leadership during the evening and weekend duties which include facilitating homework times and checking on the condition of the buildings and facilities on the farm.

Goal Three: We want every student to know they are saved, empowered, and on a secure

foundation with God. This is achieved through the following class: Being Born Again, Living in Forgiveness, Water Baptism (six students were baptized this year), Holy Spirit Baptism, and Living the Life series by Ellel Ministries. During this time we also began the following classes to equip the students: How to Pass Your Class @ Eagles; How to Come to Class Prepared; How to care for your books, keep a file, take notes, study, write assignments; and How to Pass a Test.



Goal Four: We want every student to actively pray, worship, read the Bible, and have awesome times alone with God. This step begins in the second month at Eagles and it builds on the time they have had in the Boiler Room from the beginning of the year. Every morning students and staff gather for an hour of worship, prayer, Bible reading, and learning how to spend time with God. Now, in the second month the students begin with more extensive prayer times. During the first term this year they had three different all night prayer times. They also begin to learn about the following topics: Intro to the Bible, What is Praise, What is Worship, Bible Reading and Devotion, Why Church, and Journaling. Also at this point the year-long classes of Drama, Dance, Gardens, and English begin.

Goal Five: We want every student to have a Luke 10:17+ Outreach Experience. This year's outreach took us to Vredendal for a prayer outreach with the Vredendal Kingdom Vision Bible School students and to volunteer for a service project with a school for disabled children.
